The Intellectual Property Office of New Zealand physical office is open for business 8.30am – 5.00pm NZDST.

Applications and documents for Patents, Trade Marks, or Designs that are submitted online on an open day will receive that day as a filing date if they are submitted no later than 11.59pm NZDST.

Applications and documents submitted online on a day when the Office is closed will receive the date of the next open day as the official filing date regardless of the date of submission.

If the deadline for filing an application or document falls on a day when the Office is closed, then the application or document will be filed on the next open day.

Please note:

- 1. As a general rule, if the details of an invention or design, for which an application for a patent or design registration is to be made, are published prior to the official filing date, it may invalidate the patent or registration. Therefore, if a patent or design application is submitted online on an official closed day, the details of the invention or design should not be publicly disclosed until after the official filing date which will be later than the date of online submission.
- 2. It is mandatory to use the <u>online case management facility</u> when communicating with IPONZ about International and New Zealand Trade Marks and Patents filed under the Patents Act 2013. Communications received outside the case management facility will not be considered valid unless exceptional circumstances exist.
